Cub Scout summer camp registration comes early. We will be sending out information about camp via email as it becomes available in the next couple weeks. Our pack will be attending Cub Scout World Camp Rokilio for Lion through Wolf scouts (K-2nd grade) and Webelos (3rd & 4th Graders) will be attending Akela’s World for summer camp, (5th graders will attend Boy Scout camp with the Troop that they transfer to in March). We will have more information regarding dates of Summer camp as we have more information to share.

We plan to put together a Winter camp that will be going to Camp Rokilio this year. At this time, we are looking into the availability of facilities and the regulations that we must follow while there. As the information comes forward and we are able to secure building for a weekend, we will get the information out to the pack.

Scout Uniform

To participate in the Popcorn Fundraising Booths your scout must have the full uniform prior to your scheduled booth. Our goal is to have all scouts in uniform before the October 8th Pack Meeting.

The uniform for our Pack is an official Scout Shirt (Blue for 1st - 3rd grade; Blue or Tan for 4th grade; and Tan for 5th grade), a neckerchief for your grade/rank level and a neckerchief slide. This is also called the “Class A” uniform. As a general rule, “Class A” Uniforms should be worn to all Den and Pack meetings. Some outdoor events will allow a “Class B” uniform (Pack T-shirt, scout camp shirt, or other scouting T-shirt), or casual clothing. If a Class A uniform is not required, we will announce it. You are never wrong wearing a Class A uniform to any scouting event!

Wear your Uniform with Pride! What’s most important is that you look neat, clean, and proud in your uniform and give a good impression of Cub Scouting to anyone who sees you. Keep your shirt tucked in. Wear regular shoes (avoid crocs, flip flops, etc.). Wear solid-colored pants or shorts (jeans are ok, but avoid athletic pants/shorts). Optional uniform components that look great include scout cap for your grade rank, scout belt, official scout pants, etc. The Red Vest is another optional component where you can wear your non-uniform patches earned at Pack and Den events. The Pack has red vests available for \$3.
